<u>Digital interventions for suicidal thinking: a tale of two reviews</u> Summary of two recent systematic reviews on digital interventions for suicidal thinking, which include more or less the same research, but come to quite different conclusions.

Loneliness and suicide: what's the link and what role does depression play? This post provides an appraisal of a recent systematic review and meta-analysis of prospective studies, which suggests that loneliness can predict future suicidal ideation and/or behaviour.

Means restriction for the prevention of suicide on roads This systematic review highlights the paucity of research around road traffic suicides and the need for future robust studies that aim to investigate the effectiveness of interventions to prevent suicide on roads.

Former prisoner perspectives This report provides an overview of the research conducted by Revolving Doors Agency as part of a review of the implementation of the Prisons & Probation Ombudsman's (PPO) recommendations into self-inflicted deaths in custody. It builds on the views and experiences of people with lived experience of the criminal justice system to consider what actions could support the mental health of prisoners and reduce the occurrence of suicide in prison.
