New pilots to support people self-isolating Health Secretary unveils new self-isolation support pilots for 9 areas across England with higher COVID-19 rates.

The high mental health burden of "Long COVID" This paper suggests that adults discharged from hospital with COVID-19 may experience 'Long COVID', where mental health symptoms are significant and linked to physical symptoms such as breathlessness. Clinicians should use brief screening questionnaires to support their recovery.

### **Cochrane Review**

Internet-based cognitive and behavioural therapies for post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) in adults While the review found some beneficial effects of I-C/BT for PTSD, the certainty of the evidence was very low due to the small number of included trials.

#### **Cochrane Clinical Answer**

How effective and safe are electronic cigarettes (ECs) for smoking cessation? Moderate-certainty evidence shows that more people probably quit smoking using nicotine ECs compared with other interventions, but the proportion of people quitting may be very low for all interventions.

Better access to healthcare for Traveller communities is key to increasing vaccination rates. New research suggests that easier access is more important than addressing beliefs about vaccine safety or the need for vaccination. Of particular importance is training in cultural competence for front-line staff in general practice.

Three effective treatments for frozen shoulder have different costs and benefits, study shows The three treatments most often offered by the NHS are physiotherapy, manipulation of the shoulder under general anaesthesia, and a form of keyhole (minimally-invasive) surgery called arthroscopic capsular release.
