<u>COVID-19 impact on people with intellectual and developmental disabilities, their</u> <u>families and professionals supporting them</u> This post provides a summary of the evidence exploring the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on people with intellectual disabilities, their families and the mental health professionals supporting them.

<u>Life for people with learning disabilities through the pandemic – Wave 2 findings</u> The findings from the second set of interviews of the Coronavirus and People with Learning Disabilities research project have been published.

<u>Overview of adult social care guidance on coronavirus (COVID-19)</u> Update (23 June) to guidance in line with recent advice for outbreaks in care homes that contain cases of the Delta variant.

<u>Research into coronavirus and people with learning disabilities</u> This research about COVID-19 and people with learning disabilities involved nearly 600 people with learning disabilities and 300 family/carers.

<u>Study offers new insights into how autistic adults camouflage behaviours</u> The research investigated camouflaging behaviours used by autistic adults in everyday social interactions.

<u>Number of autistic people in mental health hospitals: latest data</u> The latest monthly <u>Assuring Transformation NHS Digital data</u> shows that in May 2021:

- In total 2,055 autistic people and people with learning disabilities are still in inpatient mental health hospitals.
- 1,165 (57%) of these people are autistic.
