Systematic Reviews

Parental death by suicide is associated with an increased risk of suicidal behaviour in offspring

Aggelos Stamos looks at a recent systematic review and meta-analysis on offspring's risk for suicidal behaviour in relation to parental death by suicide.

A systematic review and mixed-methods synthesis of the experiences, perceptions and attitudes of prison staff regarding adult prisoners who self-harm

There are mixed attitudes and perceptions toward self-harm among prison staff. Further training, support and resources are required to protect staff's well-being and improve self-harm prevention and management in prisons.

Randomised Controlled Trials

<u>Effectiveness of a resilience-targeted intervention based on "I have, I am, I can"</u> <u>strategy on nursing home older adults' suicidal ideation: a randomized controlled</u> <u>trial</u>

The findings support the benefits of resilience training based on the "I have, I am, and I can" strategy in reducing suicidal ideation and suicide-related symptoms in nursing home older adults, and provide insight into possible mechanisms.

The effect of a therapeutic smartphone application on suicidal ideation in young adults: Findings from a randomized controlled trial in Australia

LifeBuoy was associated with superior improvements in suicidal ideation severity, but not secondary mental health outcomes, compared to the control application, LifeBuoy-C. Digital therapeutics may need to be purposefully designed to target a specific health outcome to have efficacy.

Study

The temporal relationships between defeat, entrapment and suicidal ideation: ecological momentary assessment study

Although entrapment is key in the pathways leading to suicidal ideation over time periods of months, our results suggest that entrapment may also account for the emergence of suicidal thoughts across time periods spanning a few hours.
