RESOURCE OF THE MONTH ORCHA (APP LIBRARY)

ORCHA (the Organisation for the Review of Care and Health Applications) is an online app library, giving you the opportunity to download, share and recommend health and care related apps.

With thousands of health and care apps available on the market, it can be hard to decide which apps are reliable and trustworthy.

- ORCHA only include apps which have been reviewed against best practice criteria.
- This allows you to map apps for either your personal or professional needs.
- Simply search for the app you are looking for or browse the contents.
- Save the apps to your favourites or recommend to others (including patients via a text/email or APP code).
- Access the Digital Health Academy for bite size training videos to gain new skills and CPD points.

Access CPD eLearning?

Are you a Trust employed consultant or SAS doctor?

What is CPD eLearning?

CPD eLearning is the online learning resource for consultant psychiatrists and other mental health professionals from the Royal College of Psychiatrists. It offers a wealth of online learning modules and podcasts covering a vast range of topics.

All modules are written by experts in their field and are peer reviewed and edited to the highest standards. Modules last between 30 and 90 minutes, and new content is added and existing content updated regularly.

Important information for existing users:

The [eLearning Hub](#) is a new learning platform introduced by the Royal College on 1st April 2022 and it replaces their CPD Online platform, which can no longer be accessed. All existing users will need to [log in to the new platform](#) in order to register and be allocated a licence. If you have not logged in to the new system by 23rd August you will not automatically have access as we will be releasing spare licences in time for the renewal of this subscription.
